How to Apply

We are thrilled that you have chosen to apply to Jordan Baptist School. Since its establishment in 1992, Jordan Baptist School has worked to teach and train the next generation. Our purpose has always been to provide a first-class, Christ-centered education. If what we believe, teach, and practice is what you desire for your children, then use the following application process in enrolling your child.

1. Apply for Admission

Jordan Baptist School is committed to making Christian education available to those who desire it; therefore, admission is not determined on the basis of race, color, gender, or nationality. The Jordan Baptist School application can be picked up from our school office or you may fill out the application on-line.

Please complete the entire application and submit it to us either by mail or on-line.

2. Interview with the Principal

Following your application submittal, you will be contacted by our school office to set up an interview with our principal. Both parents (if applicable) and student(s) are required to attend the interview.

In order for a prospective student to be enrolled, the parent(s) and student(s) must be in agreement about having a desire to enroll in Jordan Baptist School. All parents and all junior high and senior high school students must sign a statement of cooperation.

The following forms should be brought to this interview:

- A. Copy of the student's transcripts from the previous school
- B. Copies of the student's birth certificate and vaccination records
- C. Copies of the student's last report card and standardized test scores (if transferring during the school year, a grade withdrawal form)
- D. Discipline records from the previous school

Students transferring from non-traditional schools (home schools, pace programs, etc.) are required to provide a notarized statement of grade level(s) and/or courses passed.

3. Student Testing

It is our goal that every child be successful at Jordan Baptist School. After the interview, a test time will be set up with you. This testing will allow us to make sure we have the right fit and placement of your student. It also enables our faculty to know your student's strengths and weaknesses. Depending on the results of the testing, he may be asked to repeat the last grade.

There is a non-refundable testing fee of \$50.00 for each student tested.

4. Acceptance

After the previous steps have been completed, you will receive a timely notification of your child's acceptance to Jordan Baptist School. This will include a phone call and also a letter indicating either your acceptance or reason for denial.

5. Enrollment

After formal acceptance, your child will be eligible for enrollment in Jordan Baptist School.

Enrollment opens April 1 of the present year. We encourage you to enroll as early as possible since it affects our ability to plan and budget for the coming year. As an incentive, those families enrolling early (before April 30th) will pay a non-refundable registration fee of \$100.00 per student. If the registration fee is paid after April 30th, however, the fee will be \$150.00 (non-refundable). If the registration fee is paid after August 1st, the fee will be \$200.00 (non-refundable).

There will also be a non-refundable book fee and a candy sale fee. See the tuition and fees page for a full breakdown.

➤ General Information

All prospective kindergarten students (K4 and K5) must be four and five years of age, respectively by September 1st of the present year.

All students must faithfully attend all the services of a Bible-believing church.

Final acceptance is contingent upon receiving and reviewing records from the previous school attended and the results of any necessary testing.

All new students are admitted to Jordan Baptist School on a probationary basis. This probationary basis will last one nine week quarter.
