Jordan Baptist School, a ministry of Jordan Baptist Church, was founded in 1992. Its purpose was to provide a first-class, Christ-centered education for its member's children. Our school implements the traditional classroom setting, where students are taught directly through a time-tested hands-on approach by qualified teachers. Our faculty, of whom most have likewise been trained in Christian schools themselves, have exhibited a strong desire to help and influence each young student to reach his potential for Christ, both academically and spiritually.

Our school uses the *A Beka* curriculum. It is a traditionally-based approach to education with the Bible integrated throughout all subject matters and textbooks. It is considered by many to be the best curriculum in the area of Christian education.

Our school is located within the building of Jordan Baptist Church, utilizing and maximizing the space that serves as Sunday school rooms on Sundays and as classrooms during the remainder of the week.

Our school provides extra-curricular opportunities for our students to become involved in school plays, sports, music, and other areas of appropriate, rewarding and enriching Christian behaviors.

Our school is a member both of the American Association of Christian Schools and the Illinois Association of Christian Schools.
